

## PENN MAY MEET NAVY ON GRIDIRON IN 1922

**Informal Negotiations Have Been Going On for Some Time. 'Tis Said. To Hold December Practice**

### DRILL FOR CORNELL

WITH the news that Pennsylvania has invited Cornell College to come to this city next season for a football game and that the contest is a possibility, comes the word that informal gatherings have been held of late in an effort to bring the Naval Academy to this city for a game.

It has been officially stated that meetings have been held recently with the end of having the Middies and the Red and Blue get together for a football game. The proposal is said to be the same as that on which the Academy and Princeton worked during the last two years, a home and away game.

One official on the University who requested that his name be withheld stated that there is a possibility and that there will be a consummated between the two institutions starting next season.

How the Navy and Cornell are both to be taken on the schedule is something that the gridiron officials are keeping about. Penn State is wanted by the Alumni Association of Penn and may get a place during 1922. Swarthmore is certain to stay and so are Pennsylvania, Pittsburgh, Lafayette and Cornell.

With the Navy and Cornell noted the Red and Blue would have an eight-game schedule that would be one of the strongest ones around in a college football year. There could just not be an easy game in the list and it would make it necessary for Penn to have one of the best defenses in the history of the institutions.

The followers of Penn expect the Red and Blue to have a good team next year with last year's freshman eleven and three-fourths of the present varsity squad back in the University. With this squad as a nucleus and at least hundred other candidates expected the coaches look for at much better eleven than Penn has had for the past two years.

Couch Heisman announced this morning that he would hold December practice drills on Franklin Field if the weather permits. It is planned to send the lead team out on Franklin Field again the present season as over all the students who have played football are coming to the University but who for one reason or another have not come out for the different teams.

In addition I also hope to have the present freshman squad work out for a couple of weeks so that I will have an opportunity to see what they have. In this way I can start next season with a much better idea of the caliber of the men I shall have to work with than any previous time.

I have already sent out over a hundred letters to men in the different schools of the University requesting them to come and see me so that I can find out what is keeping them off Franklin Field. It is too bad that over a hundred men who admittedly have played football before should be unable to report for the college team. I am going to put out the reason and remedy if it is at all possible.

Heisman was asked what his schedule would be during December and he stated with emphasis that he meant to run the squad through the whole gamut of football.

"I INTEND to have scrimmages every afternoon the first week, for it is only through actual work that a player learns football. The fundamentals will, of course, be taught to the green players. I expect to have a number of old-time gridiron stars escort me to this work, which I think will go a long way in aiding us next season."

The head coach also announced that he would resume spring practice which was not held last season. The fact that the different sports overlap makes it hard to hold practice in the spring according to Heisman, but for all the men who desire it he will be available for six weeks in the spring to teach them anything they may want to know about the game.

**Navy Straw Hat Day, Attention**

In line with the Navy-Penn football talk it was announced this morning that the annual straw hat day game on Franklin Field would find the Middies and not Princeton as the party of the second part. The Naval Academy authorities have given permission to the diamond stars for the trip.

Twenty-six Games on Penn Quintet's List
