

"MARIE THE VAMP" FLEES N. Y. PRISON

Notorious Girl Thief, Wanted Here, Escapes by Sliding Down Rope of Sheets

DESCENDS ON ROOF, LEAPS

A thrilling escape from the State Reformatory for Girls at Bedford, N. Y., by a 100-foot slide down a rope of sheets is the latest exploit of "Marie the Vamp," according to the information received yesterday by Major Wynne, chief county detective.

"Marie the Vamp," known to police as Marie de Salvo, and who's real name is Henrietta Cosman, although only nineteen years old, is one of the most daring women thieves in the east, and is badly wanted by Philadelphia police and the police of several other cities.

FIRE DOES \$100,000 DAMAGE TO TACOY PLANT

L. H. Martin Co., Lamp Black Manufacturers, Suffers Loss

Fire discovered at 4:30 o'clock this morning in the L. H. Martin Company, plant, lamp black manufacturers, Wisconsin and Bleigh streets, Tacoy, caused a loss estimated at \$100,000.

It took the firemen four hours to extinguish the blaze. Neighboring properties were endangered, and many of the residents moved their furniture to the street.

Several of the fire-fighters suffered from burns and the effect of smoke. The fire spread rapidly, and by the time the firemen arrived the building was a mass of flames. Fumes from the burning lamp black hampered the firemen.

Firemen are still on the scene guarding against another outbreak.
