To Can Pumpkin. Wash and pare the pumpkins and cut in small pieces and then cook until soft; fill into sterilized jars and adjust rubber and lid, partly tightening the lid...

Newport Baked Apples. Select ten large firm tart apples, now pare thin strips from the top, bottom and middle of apples. Core, making extra large hole in center of apple. Now place in mixing bowl.

Apple Fritters. Pare and grate sufficient apples to make one cup. Add one egg, one-half cup sugar, one-half cup flour, one-half cup milk, one-half cup raisins, one-half cup nuts, one-half cup currants, one-half cup walnuts, one-half cup almonds, one-half cup pecans, one-half cup hazelnuts, one-half cup chestnuts, one-half cup pineapples, one-half cup mangoes, one-half cup guavas, one-half cup papayas, one-half cup melons, one-half cup cantaloupes, one-half cup watermelons, one-half cup honeydews, one-half cup muskmelons, one-half cup cantaloupes, one-half cup watermelons, one-half cup honeydews, one-half cup muskmelons.

measure two cups. Now mince very fine five strips of bacon and brown nicely; turn in a mixing bowl and add the prepared apples. Three tablespoons sirup, one cup milk or water, one teaspoon salt, one-fourth teaspoon nutmeg, three cups flour, two level tablespoons baking powder. Beat to mix, drop by spoonful in smoking hot fat and cook two minutes. Serve with ham or pot roast.

Fried Bananas. Peel bananas; roll in flour and then prepare a batter as follows: Place in mixing bowl: One and one-half cups flour, two tablespoons sirup, one teaspoon salt, one cup milk or water, three teaspoons baking powder. Three cups flour, then dip in the prepared bananas and fry a golden brown in smoking hot fat, roll the fried bananas in finely chopped nuts just as soon as you remove them from the hot fat. Serve as a vegetable.

Clam Pie. Mince twelve clams fine, three and one-half potatoes, chop five four onions, one-half cup of finely chopped parsley. Line a shallow pudding pan with plain pastry. Now place a layer of the potatoes, sprinkle with finely chopped onions, then with the parsley, now a layer of finely minced clams, season to taste.
