

\$500 FOR SISTERS OF POOR

Hospitals and Churches Also Benefit From Annie O'Brien's Will
The Little Sisters of the Poor, a West Philadelphia society, received a bequest of \$500 in the will of Annie E. O'Brien, of this city, probated today. She died in Havana, Cuba, leaving an estate valued at \$11,970. Besides private bequests she left \$3000 to St. Rose's Free Hospital for Cancer, New York, and \$2000 to Sisters of Charity, Mt. Hope Retreat, Baltimore. The residue

of the estate will be divided among the Catholic Church Extension Society of the United States, Society for the Atonement, of New York, and the Catholic Foreign Missions Society of America. Other wills probated today included that of Ida Thompson, 1103 West Toga street, \$5400, and Michael F. Gales, 1915 East Cambria street, \$4200. An inventory was filed in the personal estate of Edwin R. Smiley, who leaves \$22,068. Letters of administration were granted in the estate of John W. Richmond, 120 North Eleventh street, \$5000, and Solomon Slutsky, 214 North Second street, \$9000.




