Sunny Garden

In selecting the location for the garden and in planning the arrangement of the crops, the gardener should understand that the amount of fertilizer, watering and care will replace sunshine. Careful consideration should be given to how many hours a day any part of the proposed garden space is shaded. As a rule, foliage crops, such as lettuce, kale and spinach, do fairly well in partial shade, but must have a minimum of three hours of sunshine a day. Plants which ripen fruits, such as tomato and eggplant, should have a minimum of five hours of sunshine each day.
