

### FACTIONAL PERIL SEEN BY PINCHOT

Says Bickering May So Disrupt Congress as to Endanger Congressional Ticket

### SEEKS AID FOR HARDING

Williamsport, April 7.—In an address here last night before the League of Women Voters, a non-partisan organization, Gifford Pinchot, independent candidate for the Republican gubernatorial nomination, sounded a warning that the "dickering of a few interested political leaders" on the gubernatorial question "may so disrupt Republican voters of the State as to endanger the congressional and senatorial tickets."

There is a sense in which the Pennsylvania primary this year is a national wide. The Republican voters will nominate not only a Governor, but members of the national House and Senate. The governorship is important, but the representation of Pennsylvania in the national Congress is equally so.

Problems to Face  
President Harding has difficult problems to face, as every President must have following a great war. Pennsylvania as the greatest Republican State must give him its fullest support in his efforts to solve these problems in the interest of the whole people.

The Republican voters in open primary can safely be trusted to nominate such a ticket as will appeal to the best sentiment of the State and lead to certain victory next fall. The danger is that the dickering of a few interested leaders may so disrupt the Republicans of the State as to endanger the ticket.

So far the harmonizers seem to have considered everything except the one question which ought to come first, namely, the protection of the interests of the people of Pennsylvania. So far I have observed that consideration has been left out.

Primaries Important  
Remember that the Pennsylvania primaries this year affect not only the State but the nation and the world, and keep the public interest and the public welfare against sordid political deals and trades.


