BROWN TO TRY FOR 600-YARD RECORD

Will Give Liberal Handicaps Tomorrow in Effort to Lower Sheppard's Mark

COACH LAWSON ROBERTSON, of the University of Pennsylvania track team, will send Captain Larry Brown, his brilliant star, after the 600-yard record tomorrow afternoon on Franklin Field.

Brown's brilliant running in the relay carnivals leads the veteran coach to believe that right now the captain of the team can break the record made by Mel Sheppard in 1910 of 1 minute 10 4-5 seconds. Brown's great half mile on Saturday in the last lap of the two-mile event of 1 minute 54 seconds shows that Brown's speed is such that he can edge the mark made by the great Sheppard.
