**DIPHTHERIA DEATH RATE IS CUT HERE**

Reduced 79 for Each 100,000 Residents of Philadelphia in Last Twenty-five Years

**GOAL NOT YET REACHED**

The death rate of diphtheria in Philadelphia in 1921 was seventeen each 100,000, according to C. Lincoln Furbush, Director of Public Health, who points out that in 1896 the death rate from this disease was ninety-six each 100,000.

"The Department of Public Health," he said, "with the co-operation of the medical profession, is waging a vigorous educational campaign in the schools, health centers, community centers and other public meetings, urging the early detection of diphtheria among children, by securing prompt medical attention for all cases of sore throat in order that an early diagnosis may facilitate the immediate use of antitoxin when it is most valuable and effective."

**GETS PAID FOR FALL**  
Worker is Allowed Compensation for Brain Lesion  
Compensation for total disability has been awarded by the Supreme Court to a workman who suffered brain lesion during the course of his employment, and has been an invalid ever since. This decision was awarded Francis Roach, who was forty-nine years old and in good health two years ago, when he suffered a fall while working for the Oswald Lever Company.  
Since then, Roach has suffered from partial loss of speech and abnormal nervous condition. The decision in Roach's favor was written by Justice Walling and affirms the judgment of Common Pleas Court No. 1, and the action of the compensation referee who allowed Roach's claim.
