

BOOMERS AIM TO ORGANIZE U. S.
 Clubs to Be Formed in Each Congressional District, Supporters Say

CALLED "BEST-KNOWN" MAN

 Detroit, June 7.—Plans for a national movement to bring about the candidacy of Henry Ford for President in 1924 were mapped last night at Dearborn, Mr. Ford's suburban home, at a permanent organization meeting of the Henry Ford for President Club.
 Similar clubs will be formed in each congressional district of the United States. This method, it was pointed out, would show Mr. Ford's strength in each district and insure him the proper congressional support should his ticket be returned the winner.
 The club decided against adopting a platform, preferring to leave Mr. Ford to work out his own ideas should he consent to enter the presidential race, and to set forth for himself the principles upon which he would go before the people.
 The Rev. Dr. William Dawe, pastor of the Dearborn Methodist Episcopal Church, was elected president of the club. In addressing the gathering he declared Mr. Ford was "the best known man of the world today," and was well fitted to head the Government and take the lead in launching reforms he considered necessary.
 "Every few centuries," Dr. Dawe continued, "a man appears at a time of great crisis, and such a crisis confronts the world today. Perhaps Mr. Ford has appeared for just such an hour as this. He has many critics, but natural leaders often are called fools and madmen. Christ was similarly criticized."

U. S. GIVES EAR TO FRANCE

Now Ready to Discuss Settlement of War Debts
 Paris, June 7.—(By A. P.)—The French Foreign Office was informed yesterday that the United States was ready now to discuss the war debts question. The Ministry of Finance afterward stated that the French mission was ready to start for the United States as soon as Premier Poincaré gave the word.
 The American notification yesterday understood in official circles as a reply to Premier Poincaré's note, informing the United States that a French mission, headed by Jean Parmentier, had been appointed and was ready to proceed to the United States whenever the American Debt Commission deemed it advisable.

EIGHT COLLEGE WOMEN APPLY FOR LAUNDRY JOB
 Cambridge and Oxford Graduates Seek Small-Paying Position
 London, June 7.—(By A. P.)—Eight women holding degrees in Oxford, Cambridge and other English universities underwent a competitive examination today for a position in a London laundry, the duties to consist of answering telephone inquiries.

The manager of the laundry, which is connected with a big hotel, recently advertised for "a courteous, even-tempered, patient, gentleman to answer the telephone," and received more than 800 applications for the position, which carries a salary of £250. Nearly all the applicants possessed the qualification of a university education which the advertisement demanded.
 The manager explains that "the job essentially requires judgment and tact of a high order, and the applicant must be able to control the office."

POLISH CABINET IS OUT
 Resignation, Tended After Election Procedure Dispute, Is Accepted
 Warsaw, June 7.—Differences of opinion having arisen in the Cabinet on the subject of the procedure in the approaching elections, Premier Poinkowski tendered the resignation of the Ministry. President Pilsudski was not successful in settling the differences and yesterday accepted the Cabinet's resignation.
