HOFFNER LEADS IN PHILA. OPEN

Philmont Pro Tops Field in Morning Round at Merion With a 78

ATTRACTS GREAT FIELD

Charley Hoffner, Philadelphia professional golf champion, who represents the Philmont Club, was the first of sixty-four golfers to tee off in the Philadelphia open championship today at Merion, and was likewise low scorer in the early cards of the morning round.

Hoffner turned in a snappy 78 for the initial eighteen holes. The pride of Philmont was not so good on the outward journey, making the turn with a 46, but negotiated the homeward journey in 26.

Close behind Hoffner and tied for second honors with 79, were James Sutor, assistant pro at the Philadelphia Country Club, who has only been here three months, and George Sayers, of Merion, the latter playing on his home course. This tourney is the first that Sutor has played in since he came to America.

This year's tilt for the open golf championship of this district attracted a wonderful field; not only because of the honor involved in winning the title, but because the monetary rewards are exceedingly worth while.
