

KATHERINE MACKAY WEDS K. R. O'BRIEN

Daughter of Clarence Mackay is Bride of Son of Former New York Jurist

New York, Sept. 22. — Miss Katherine Mackay, elder daughter of Mr. Clarence H. Mackay, was married yesterday afternoon in St. Mary's Church, Roslyn, L. I., to Mr. Kenneth R. O'Brien, youngest son of former Justice Morgan J. O'Brien and Mrs. O'Brien, of New York and Southampton, L. I.

A few hundred guests, members of the two families and personal friends of the couple, attended the ceremony. Two thousand additional guests attended the reception, from 5 until 7 o'clock, in the gardens at Harbor Hill, the country home of Mr. Mackay, near Roslyn, where the guests at the ceremony and reception was Mrs. John W. Mackay, the grandmother of the bride.

Mr. O'Brien and his bride have gone to Gardiner's Island for part of their wedding trip. Their home is to be the E. B. Allen estate at Hempstead, L. I., not far from Harbor Hill and near the Meadow Brook Club. Opposite the property is the former Hempstead home of Mr. and Mrs. August Belmont.

The day before the wedding Mr. Mackay was informed that Pope Pius XI had bestowed the papal benediction upon the bride and groom.

For more than an hour men, women and children had gathered about the church lawn. When Miss Mackay and her father arrived the crowd greeted her with cheers and handclapping and rushed forward, the children going first with hats and handkerchiefs. The bride responded by waving back. A second demonstration, even more vociferous than the first, awaited her when she and the bridegroom came from the church.


