HARDING PRAISES RED CROSS RELIEF

Large Fund to Be Expended for Work in the Near East

JOB TO BE DONE QUICKLY

Washington, Oct. 9.—President Harding, in a message of welcome, read at the initial session today of the national convention of the American Red Cross, expressed his gratification at the steps being taken by the organization in co-operation with the Near East Relief to aid refugees in the Near East.

Ready to Fill Emergency Mr. Harding, in his message addressed to Chairman Payne, asked Mr. Payne to express to the convention the "very cordial greetings and the satisfaction that I feel in knowing of this annual session of the delegates from the various states, which give to the American Red Cross its untiring strength and readiness for every emergency."

No Specific Sum Named Chairman Payne, in explaining the action of the Executive Committee, said that the first action of the Red Cross would be to proceed to meet the emergency as considered existing in the Near East.
