America Note Means Another Peace Meet, Is Japanese Opinion

Tokio, April 11.—(By The Associated Press)—Newspapers here have given great prominence to the note from Charles E. Hughes, American secretary of state, to the allies relative to mandates and partition of the former German Island of Yap. There has been no official comment, but in responsible unofficial circles the opinion is held that the American note virtually implies another peace conference.

Statements made by Vice Admiral Tomosaburo Kato, minister of marine, last month, relative to the Japanese naval policy are regarded here as having tended to answer charges that Japan is incurably militaristic and is insisting upon naval expansion. These statements, which were made to the Associated Press, are also looked upon as paving the way for an international discussion of naval policies. Representative Japanese declared that if the naval race between Great Britain and the United States ceases, Japan might be obliged eventually to drop out because of financial considerations.

Yukio Ozaki, former minister of justice, and one of the leaders in the movement for a curtailment of naval expenditures delivered lectures to great crowds in fifteen cities recently, and he announced that 90 per cent of the people who heard him expressed themselves in favor of armament reductions.

Publishing Vice Admiral Kato's statements Niichi Niichi Shimbu of this city, quoted naval officials as saying that the minister of marine clearly explained Japan's position. They were of the opinion that President Harding would call a naval conference but emphasized the fact that the real difficulty would come in carrying out a reduction of naval programs.

The Yomi-Uri Shimbu of this city believed it is convinced that Mr. Kato consulted the cabinet before making his statements, and, therefore, they can be interpreted as embodying the intentions of the government. The newspaper says that considering the minister's insistent attitude on the subject of armament reduction, his new declaration was surprisingly inconsistent and liable to confuse people as to its real significance.

Copenhagen, April 11.—M. J. Ballin, one of the foremost figures in Danish industry, died early Monday as a result of a self-inflicted bullet wound. Ballin, who was active in Germany, was very proud of the industrial concern of Ballin's Soenner, of which he was the leading spirit, and was reputed to have spent his private fortune in a vain attempt to prevent the decline of the stock of the company, which was quoted at 60 Monday against 320 in 1918.

In consequence of his German sympathies Ballin was prominently named on the allied "black list" during the war.

Washington, April 11.—The seating of Richard E. Bird, a Republican representative from the Eighth Kansas district, was protested on the floor of the house Monday by Representative Flood, Democrat, Virginia. At his own suggestion, Mr. Bird stood aside until the other members had been sworn in. Mr. Bird charged that he had spent more than \$10,000, twice the amount a candidate for representative was permitted to expend under the federal corrupt practices act.

The house adopted a resolution by Representative Mondell, Republican leader, seating Mr. Bird.

Tacoma, April 11.—Two persons are dead here Monday and three injured as a result of traffic accidents. Thomas Dean, 65, was struck by Milwaukee train and instantly killed. Mrs. Laura Cushman, 56, was struck by an automobile driven by J. G. Newbegin, lumberman, and died shortly after. An automobile containing three men was completely demolished at Orting when struck by a Northern Pacific train. Frank Darby may die from his internal injuries.

SMOOTHERS IN SAWDUST BIN Aberdeen, Wn., April 11.—Hugh Rogers, 25, a fireman's helper at the Bay City mill, fell headfirst into a slide of sawdust in a bin which he had been sent to clear, and died by suffocation before help could reach him.

GOVERNOR SIGNS IOWA CIGARETTE MEASURE Des Moines, April 11.—Governor Kendall signed the cigarette bill Monday which permits the sale of cigarettes in Iowa to adults.

Ex-Kaiser and Prince Adalbert at Bedside; Only Daughter Absent

Villagers of Doorn Grieve; Body Will Be Taken to Potsdam.

Doorn, Holland, April 11.—(By The Associated Press).—Former Empress Augusta Victoria of Germany died here at 6 o'clock Monday morning. By a strange coincidence the end came just one year after she suffered her first serious attack of heart disease.

It was while she was preparing to enter the house of Doorn, the present home of the former emperor of Germany, after her long residence at Ammerongen that she was stricken with what at the time was believed to be a fatal attack.

Interval Attacks. That was on April 11, 1920. For a few days there were reports that her death was momentarily expected, but she rallied, and accompanied her husband to Doorn May 15 last.

Attacks of her fatal malady recurred at frequent intervals, each sapping her vitality and nullifying the measures taken by specialists to restore her health. When her son, former Prince Joachim, committed suicide in Berlin last July, she was in a serious condition that news of his death was kept from her for a long time and it is said she never learned he killed himself.

Husband at Bedside. Last autumn the former empress' condition gradually became worse, and on several occasions her children were called in to attend to her, but her strength was such that she rallied bravely when the end was believed imminent. Since the first of the year, it had been known that she was gradually sinking.

Final Services at Potsdam. London, April 11.—Funeral services over the body of the late former Empress Augusta Victoria of Germany will be held at the house of Doorn Tuesday and will be attended by only members of her family, says an Amsterdam dispatch to the Central News. The body will be taken to Potsdam Wednesday and another funeral service will be held there.

It is stated that former Emperor William will accompany the body as far as the Dutch frontier, the dispatch adds.

Crown Prince Advised. Wieringen, Holland, April 11.—Ex-Crown Prince Frederick William was informed early today of the death of his mother, he prepared immediately to go to Doorn awaiting the arrival of the Dutch authorities to accompany him thither.

SINN FEMERS ATTACK HOTEL IN EARLY A. M.

Bombs and Firearms Used in Battle; One Civilian Is Killed.

Crown Forces Taken by Surprise; Reinforcements Rout Men.

Dublin, April 11.—A battle raged for 20 minutes Monday morning around the Northwestern hotel, in the north wall section here, when civilians armed with bombs and firearms fiercely attacked the hotel, where government auxiliaries are quartered. One of the assaulting party was killed and several were wounded, two of them seriously. A number of the auxiliaries are believed to have been wounded during the fighting.

The attackers began their onslaught as the dock workers were proceeding to their places of employment. Bombs and poison gas missiles and bottles of petrol were hurled into the hotel precincts, after which rifles and revolvers were used freely from three sides. The auxiliaries taken by surprise sprang to points of vantage, some of them in pajamas and engaged in a brisk 20 minute battle until reinforcements arrived. The attackers then withdrew, leaving a quantity of bombs.

Cork, April 11.—Two constables were shot at daylight Sunday morning while walking along a street in the village of Kildorrey, near here. Both of them died later in the day.

Greeks Flee Before Turks; Losses Heavy Is Asia Minor Report

Paris, April 11.—News from Asia Minor received in Paris during the past 24 hours indicates that the Turks are pursuing the Greeks in the southern sector of the front to the north in the region of Brusa.

Afun-Karahisar, the important junction point on the Bagdad railway, has been retaken by the Turks. Three divisions of the Greek northern army have lost an aggregate of 6200 killed and wounded.
