Equipment Shipped to Ranger Stations in Preparation for Summer Season.
Files, axes, mess kits and other equipment for use of fire fighters in the Lewis and Clark and Jefferson national forests amounting in value to about \$100,000 were shipped to the 17 ranger stations in these forests Thursday. Adolph Weholt, in charge of the fire protection on the forests, stated that the plans for prevention and protection against forest fires have been made more efficient this year. No larger force for first protection will be employed this year unless fires should develop.
