

5 STORE ROOMS IN NEW STEELE BUILDING TAKEN

Structure at Third and Central Avenue Will Be Ready Before July 1.

The new Steele building, Central avenue and Third street, will be ready for occupancy on or a short time before July 1. With all of its store rooms occupied, it was stated Monday on reliable authority: All of the Central avenue locations have been leased, two rooms on the Third street side have been taken, and deals are understood to be pending for the remaining rooms. The corner location and all of the basement not given over to storage space for leases will be occupied by the W. R. Wilcoxson cigar store and billiard room. The cigar store and sporting goods counter will be on the ground floor, with a corner entrance, and the billiard tables will occupy a basement space 40 to 100 feet in size. The basement extends 10 feet under the sidewalk, making it 10 feet longer than the half block. Mr. Wilcoxson has conducted the Park billiard parlors at 110 Central avenue for the last 11 years. It was stated that negotiations are now under way for the leasing of this location to persons who will occupy it immediately after Mr. Wilcoxson vacates.

For Gage Specialty Shop. An ell-shaped room adjoining the corner location in the Steele building on both the avenue and street sides will be occupied by the Gage Specialty shop, which has been at 417 Central avenue since the old Steele building burned in March, 1920. The shop will have street and avenue entrances and the store room between will be continuous, bending around the corner of the Wilcoxson store.

Locations west of the Gage Specialty shop on the avenue side will be the Crown Jewelry store and the Two Little Tailors, and the room adjoining the alley on Third street will be occupied by the Great Falls Dye House, according to Frary & Burlingame, agents for the building. The Crown Jewelry store is now at 221 Central avenue, the Great Falls Dye house at 405 First avenue south and the Two Little Tailors at 19 1/2 Third street south. Deals will probably be closed within the months for the locations on the Third street entrance of the Gage Specialty shop and the Great Falls Dye house.

Applications for Liberty. Harry Newman, agent for the Liberty theater building, across Third street from the Steele building, stated Monday that many of his locations have been applied for and that an announcement of the building's tenants will be made within a short time. Several leases will be closed up within the next few days, he expects. Both the theater and Steele buildings will be opened about July 1, but the exact date for either opening has not been determined.
