Sanctions Exchange of Pupils Between Mexico and United States. Los Angeles, Cal.—(Correspondence of the Associated Press.)—Exchange of students between universities in Mexico and the United States, a plan fostered by business and educational workers in both countries, is being encouraged and recommended by President Oregon as a means of bringing about a better understanding between the two nations, according to advices received here.

Recognizing the value of complete reciprocity, however, and the advantage of familiarizing the United States' representatives with Mexico, the Mexican president has asked that 12 professors from American universities visit Mexico to study archeology, Spanish, geology, Mexican history and other subjects. The visitors are to have their fare paid by the Mexican government and to receive the sum of 2,000 pesos annually.

The Mexican government, the letter adds, "will authorize these privileges in exchange for the scholarships which the United States will give to our students. We will work in complete harmony with the committee that has been formed in furtherance of the exchange plan."

The movement was set on foot by the American Chamber of Commerce in Mexico, and has been placed before the National Foreign Trade convention and other commercial organizations in the United States, besides the universities. The executive secretary of the movement in Mexico is O. R. W. Cook, formerly of Los Angeles, a graduate of the University of Southern California.
