

# Federal Solicitor General Warns Nation Against Lawlessness

## Underground Rumbling of Revolt Heard in Most Stable of Governments

### Morale of Industry Has Been Shattered, Says Beck, and This Age Has Become Pre-eminent-ly One of Sham and Counterfeit; Says Crime Has Shown Unprecedented Growth.

Cincinnati, Aug. 31.—Revolt against tradition and authority has sprung up not only against the political state, but in music, art, poetry and commerce, until the age has become "pre-eminent-ly one of sham and counterfeit," James M. Beck, solicitor general of the United States declared before the American bar association Wednesday. He spoke on the spirit of lawlessness.

The statistics of our criminal courts in recent years show an unprecedented growth in crime," Mr. Beck said, "but this revolt against authority is not confined to the political state. In music its fundamental elements have been thrown aside and discord has replaced harmony. Its culmination—jazz—is a musical crime.

"In the plastic arts, the criteria of beauty of rhythm and nobility of thought have been replaced by exaltation of the grotesque and brutal.

Sham and Counterfeit.

"In commerce, the revolt is one against purity of standards and the integrity of business morals. Who can question that this is pre-eminent-ly the age of sham and counterfeit?" "Two of the oldest empires in the world are in a welter of anarchy," even the most stable governments, the underground rumblings of revolution may be heard. This war of extermination has put us back—temporarily let us hope a thousand years—into the primitive of industrial civilization. Work for work's sake as the most glorious privilege of human faculties, has gone. The aversion to work is the great evil of the world today. The whole history of the mechanical era is a persistent struggle for more pay and shorter hours and today it has culminated in world-wide ruin. In my judgment, the economic catastrophe of 1921 is far greater than the political-military chapter of 1919.

Accompanying the in-Disposition to work, the solicitor general continued there has been a marked desire for pleasure such as has not been seen within the memory of living man."

Against Laws.

"Man has danced upon the verge of social abyss and even the dancing has reverted to the primitive forms of uncivilized conditions," Mr. Beck declared. Speaking of newspapers, he deplored the increase in "the ephemeral and trivial" saying that pages were devoted to sport, "while literary, art and musical reviews and scientific designs were omitted or given little space. "Undoubtedly there are many contributing causes to this world wide revolution," Mr. Beck continued. "Thus the multiplicity of laws does not tend to develop a law abiding spirit. A race of individuals obey reluctantly when they obey at all, any laws they regard as unreasonable or vexatious. The laws delay and laxity in administration breed a spirit of contempt and too often invite men to take the law into their own hands.

Suggests No Remedy.

"I may seem unduly pessimistic," Mr. Beck continued, and I can suggest no remedy but there are many palliatives for the evils I have discussed but to work for work's sake. The law and our profession can defend the spirit of individualism, the noblest expression in the constitution of the United States.

## FIRE DESTROYS LARGE BALLOON; HANGAR BURNED

### Largest Aircraft of U. S. Lost in Explosion at Rockaway Air Station.

### Big Dirigible Was to Be Moved Thursday to Hurst Lake Depot.

New York, Aug. 31.—Dirigible balloon D-6 the largest naval aircraft of its type, the Blimp III, and the kite balloon A P were destroyed by a fire which also burned the hangar at the Rockaway point naval air station. An explosion of gasoline from an unknown cause, started the blaze although a number of men were in the hangar only one man was slightly burned.

Great tanks containing thousands of cubic feet of hydrogen were located near the hangar and the firemen played tons of water upon them to prevent possible explosions. The D-6 was 196 feet long, carried a crew of four and had a speed of 60 miles an hour. She was used to patrol the coast.

Continued fair weather ordered all activities at the air station to cease Thursday. It was understood the D-6 was being prepared for transportation to the new hangar at Lakehurst, N. J., built to receive the ill fated Z-R recently destroyed in England.

## Greek Troops Break Through Left Wing of Turkish Defense

Constantinople, Aug. 31.—(By The Associated Press.)—The Greek troops in Asia Minor have broken through the left wing of the Turkish nationalist army, which has lost its initiative of the last few days, and the Greeks have crossed the Sakaria River. Certain contingents of the Greeks also have crossed the Iliza river and are storming the second Turkish defense line.

## Hope Still Exists That Lost Canadian Ship Is Yet Afloat

Vancouver, B. C., Aug. 31.—Hope had not altogether vanished at the offices of the Canadian government merchant marine here Wednesday that the lost Canadian importer was still afloat. There is a probability that the vessel has drifted out of the area of search and working on this theory all vessels out of California ports bound for the Orient are being asked to keep a close watch for the missing ship. The steamer Niagara enroute from Australia, due to arrive Sept. 30, will be asked to look out for the derelict. Strong winds and gales from all points of the compass have prevailed in the vicinity of the last given location of the importer, during the last few days.

## Hold Soldier Bonus Is Unconstitutional in State of New York

Albany, N. Y., Aug. 31.—The New York state soldier bonus law is unconstitutional according to a decision of the court of appeals handed down here Wednesday. The opinion, written by Judge Andrews held that the bonus law involved the gifts of the states credit, which is prohibited by the state constitution. Judges Cardozo and Pound dissented.

## Roads Do Not Plan to "Turn Over" Savings to Shippers

Washington, Aug. 31.—Even though railroad operating expenses were reduced by wage cuts or otherwise, the carriers could not be expected to "hand over" to the shippers the entire savings thus effected so long as the carriers fall to earn the 6 per cent return contemplated by the transportation act, Conrad E. Spang, vice president of the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy railroad, testified Wednesday before the interstate commerce commission in the grain rate hearing. He said, however, that a large saving in expenses would in all probability be followed by freight rate reductions.

## Body of Yank Airman Killed in ZR-2 Is Recovered in Wreck

Hull, England, Aug. 31.—The body of Chief Mechanist Mate George W. Wh of Elgin, Ill., who lost his life in the ZR-2 disaster here a week ago was recovered from the wreckage Wednesday. Two more bodies later were found. One was that of Flight Sergeant Wilson of the Royal aviation force which was discovered in the Humber near Brongh. The other, which has not been identified was washed up in the Holderness district.

## Captain of Vessel That Rammed Liner Has License Revoked

Seattle, Aug. 31.—Suspension of the master's license of Captain John Alwen for two years by Supervising Inspector William Fisher of Seattle, advised by Inspector General George Uhle of the United States steamboat inspection service at Washington in a decision received here Wednesday. Captain Alwen was master of the freighter West Hartland when she rammed and sank the passenger liner Governor April 1 at the entrance to Puget Sound.
