FLATHEAD PROJECT TO BE TAKEN UP IN STUDY BY EXPERTS

U. S. Water Power Representatives to Arrive in State Sunday; Vast Scheme.

Special to The Tribune. Helena, Sept. 21.—Steps to get under way the vast power, irrigation and railway electrification project that is to develop the possibilities of Flathead lake and branches of the upper Columbia river...

ould Sunday, go to Polson the following day and then spend several days at the lake and on the Flathead and Pend d'Oreille rivers.

Among the propositions before the investigators are the storage of waters in the Flathead lake sufficient to irrigate the 1,750,000 acres of the Columbia basin project in Washington and the development of sufficient power to operate by electricity the Rocky mountain lines of the Great Northern and Northern Pacific railways.

The Montana Power company has on file at Washington, D. C., an application for a water power site at the outlet of Flathead lake...

O. C. Morrell, executive secretary of the federal power commission, outlined the purpose of the investigation as a "general study of the upper Columbia river, beginning at Flathead lake, with a view of outlining a scheme of development best suited to the needs of power, irrigation and navigation."

Federal representatives are Colonel James B. Cavanaugh, engineer for the federal power commission; D. C. Henry, federal reclamation service; E. E. Henshaw, federal geological survey, and Colonel Schulz, unattached. Mr. Chase, supervisor of hydraulics for the state of Washington, represents his state.
