GORDON'S MEN TAKE STEPICH AND PIPINICH

Arrest Proprietors and Clerks in Raids Monday; Claim Liquor Found.

Deputies from Sheriff Bob Gordon's office raided two places Monday afternoon, arrested four men and seized a quantity of liquor which will be used as evidence of liquor sales against the prisoners.

A short time before the deputies searched the Stepich place, the cigar store of Joe Pipinich, in Black Eagle, was raided and the proprietor and Ernest Genest, the clerk, placed under arrest.

Authorities say they have evidence in their possession to establish the charge that Stepich has sold liquor in his place. Stepich is now booked for the next term of district court on a charge of transporting liquor.

SUE TO RECOVER FARM FROM McVAY

Owners Allege That Lessee Has Violated Contract and Defaulted Payment.

A. B. McVay, breeder of blooded stock, is named defendant in a contract action filed Monday in district court by Frank Coombs and Thomas C. King, owners of the Neil Creek ranch held under lease by the defendant.

The complaint reads that the plaintiffs, on May 7, 1921, leased the Neil creek ranch to McVay for a period of 18 months, under an agreement that \$2,240 rent be paid each year.

Because of this alleged failure to pay half of the yearly rent, the plaintiffs claim that they have been damaged to the extent of \$1,000 through the defendant's alleged waste, injury and unlawful detention of the property.
