83 States Represented among 155 Students From Outside of Montana. Special to The Tribune. Missoula, Nov. 17.—The total registration of State university on November 1 was 1205, the highest ever reached by the institution. This is more than 200 over the total registration of the fall quarter last year. Of this number 641 are men and 564 women. The school of business administration leads in the registration by schools. Including those who are taking courses in arts and sciences preparing to major in business administration, the number of students in the school of forestry comes second with a registration of 147. There are 100 registered in the school of journalism, 42 in pharmacy, 57 majoring in law and 36 pre-legal students.
