## WOUNDED MAN SUMMONS HELP WITH HIS GUN

Gerrie Hay Accidentally Shot in Mountains; Found Before He Freezes.

With a gunshot wound accidentally inflicted while hunting in the Belt mountains last Saturday afternoon, exposed to the biting cold as he lay helpless in the snow, Gerrie Hay of Monarch a former deputy county assessor, was found by his hunting companion, Dean Goings, who with the assistance of others brought him to Great Falls after a grueling journey that ended at 5:30 o'clock Monday morning.

**Wounded in Ankle.**  
Hay was taken to the home of Dr. L. R. McBurney, 1708 Third avenue north, who was called to the aid of the wounded man as soon as word could be relayed from the mountains. Dr. McBurney said Monday evening that Hay's condition was not serious, but that every precaution was being taken to prevent infection of the wound.

A steel jacketed bullet, discharged when the gun slipped from his grasp, entered above Hay's ankle and virtually stripped the shin bone of all its flesh.  
Hay and his companion had become separated during the hunt. The former, while testing a rock slide, lost his army rifle and before he could recover it a stone struck the trigger and caused it to be discharged. Although severely wounded, Hay succeeded in recovering his gun and an exchange of shots between he and Goings brought about his discovery.

**Was Rigorous Trip.**  
By several means of conveyance, by manpower and use of horses, the wounded man was brought to a point where he could be reached by Dr. McBurney in his automobile. Dr. McBurney traveled stretches of road never before covered by a machine and he started Monday night that he never hoped to make a trip under the circumstances of the ride past Camp Rotary to the reaches of Hover creek. The return to Great Falls was made with the thermometer registering below the zero mark.
