NOT IN ANY HURRY

New Labor Commissioner Will Proceed with Care.

EIGHT-HOUR DAY Bill Introduced in the Senate by McGowan of Minneapolis.

Senator McGowan of Minneapolis has introduced a bill in the legislature which seeks to establish eight hours as a legal day's work in this state for state employes and persons working on material used in state work.

The bill refers to "all laborers, workmen, mechanics and clerks employed upon any public works of the state, now employed by the state or in the employ of any person or firm contracting with the state."
