LAW PROPOSED IN INDIANA. Wife Beaters, Tramps and Drunkards, Too, Are to Feel the Lash. New York Sun Special Service. Indianapolis, Ind., Jan. 24.—A bill has been prepared for introduction in the legislature to establish a whipping post in every county and it provides that every man who deserts his family and leaves it upon public charity is to get from thirty to seventy-five lashes and the public drunkard, on his fourth offense, from ten to twenty-five. The whip used shall be of rawhide and shall be wielded by the sheriff or deputy.

Just at the time Morgan's brokers were reaching out for Delaware and Hudson, however, the Delaware and Hudson directors met and increased the regular dividend 2 per cent. It was a complete surprise to everybody, especially Mr. Morgan, and the stock immediately soared so high it could not be reached in a balloon.
