RELIEF IN BED

"Run for Dicky" at Harvard Is Said to Be Dangerous.

TWO STUDENTS ARE INJURED

Faculty May Take Up the Matter on the Return of President Elliot.

Special to The Journal. Boston, April 8.—Because of hazing, two Harvard students, after being initiated into the fraternity of H. O. and D. K. E., have been obliged to leave the university temporarily.

Mason was taken out for his "first stunt" at the phrase given, about a month ago.

Relief Pictures and Busts in the Congressional Library.

IT'S ELLEN TERRY'S SUGGESTION

Japanese Artist Made a Bust of General Harrison Look Like a Japanese.

Washington, April 8.—There is a large collection of busts and relief portraits of authors, poets, musicians, statesmen and other distinguished persons in the copyright division of the library of congress, accumulated during many years.

To Ellen Terry is due the suggestion, carried out by Librarian Putnam. During her visit to Washington, she met a number of those that frequent the reading-room for the blind at the congressional library and sent them tickets to one of her matinees.

At the time of the death of ex-President Harrison these people were much interested in him and his history. A bust of the general, which has been sent to the copyright division by a well-known Japanese artist, was sent to the reading-room, and the blind people exclaimed in breath: "The Japanese our president was!"

It is no longer the custom to send either a bust or relief of the subject for copyright, but a photograph, so the collection will not grow.

Reconsidered Their Request When the Editor's Reply Came—Lecture at Lake City.


