GRAND ENCAMPMENT

J. W. Horner Brings Good Reports of the New Town.

J. W. Horner of this city, who is heavily interested in various Wyoming mining properties, has just returned from Grand Encampment in that state.

Mr. Horner reports great activity in all mining pursuits in Wyoming, and says that republican prosperity has struck that section of the country in no uncertain manner.

The town of Grand Encampment has now 800 people and there are about 8,000 miners at work in the camp, all of which is the result of two years' development of the mines.

The town boasts of the only smelter in Wyoming, and is preparing to extend the scope of mining operations in that vicinity.

The general conditions of the country, Mr. Horner says, were never better. There is abundant employment for all classes of mechanics, and it is almost impossible to get sufficient help to prosecute the work about Grand Encampment.

Carpenters get 45 cents an hour and bricklayers and plasterers 70 cents for their work. Common laborers are paid \$2 per day. Room and board can be had at the best hotel for \$2 per week.

Mr. Horner brought back with him a fine box of gold and copper specimens from the Grand Encampment district, which are on exhibition in the city ticket office of the Minneapolis & St. Louis, corner Hennepin and Washington avenues. The specimens are very rich, the copper chunks running about 70 per cent pure copper and the gold specimens indicating an average of \$16 to the ton.
