

COCAINE IN SPINE

Paralysis Produced and a Leg Amputated.

NEW OPERATION IN NEW YORK

Insensibility of the Limb Produced Without the Use of Ether or Chloroform.

New York, June 1.—For the second time in the history of surgery the operation of producing temporary paralysis instead of using an anesthetic was performed at Bellevue hospital. It consists of injecting cocaine into the spinal canal, thereby producing paralysis of the lower portion of the body. The first operation was performed only three weeks ago, in Bellevue also, and, like the first, promises to be entirely successful.

The patient was Hester McCallum, 60 years old, of 117 West Twenty-sixth street. Her right leg was cut off above the knee by Professor Curtis of the visiting staff, assisted by Drs. Phillips and Johnson.
