WOMAN SUFFRAGE WINS IN NORWAY

Victorious Struggle of the Other Sex for Political Rights—The Privilege at Present is Confined to Municipal Elections—First of the New Law to Occur in October.

In a recent letter to the Chicago Record-Herald W. E. Curtis shows how Norway has taken the lead of the European nations in extending the electoral franchise to women.

Being one of the most progressive of nations, it is not surprising that Norway should extend the electoral franchise to women in 1894.

Many of the wisest men in Norway consider the universal suffrage amendment to the constitution, which was passed in 1894, a mistake for this reason—because it removed the right of suffrage from men to accumulate money.

Up till 1898 the men of Norway who were over 25 years of age enjoyed universal suffrage for national affairs, but taxpayers and rate payers only were allowed to vote in municipal elections.

This authority is derived from a law called by forty-eight members, according to the population of the parish, who were elected for terms of three years to serve gratuitously.
