Wrecked power-house was a substantial one-story brick structure, 50x50, divided into three rooms—a boiler room, a dynamo room and pumping room. The equipment of the plant consisted of three boilers, one 125-horse power and two 40-horse power, two dynamos, with a capacity of 2,000 incandescent lights and two 100-horse power pumps.
