MINNEAPOLIS AHEAD STRENGTH IN IRON

Does Better Than Any Other State at the Pan-Am.

AWARDS MADE BY THE JURIES

Three Gold, Four Silver and Six Bronze Medals for the State at Large.

Special to the Journal. Pan-American Exposition, Buffalo, N.Y., Oct. 10.—Minnesota as a state gets two gold, four silver and six bronze medals and diploma of honorable mention.

Several states received awards through private organizations such as chambers of commerce, etc., that had little or no recognition as state exhibitors.

Four of the six bronze medals are for flour exhibited in the state flour booth, while the fifth is for the grain and grass flour in the agricultural booth.

Private exhibitors, some under state auspices, are Pillsbury-Washburn company, gold medal for "Pillsbury's Best"; Washburn-Crosby company, gold medal for "Gold Medal" flour; Erickson Artificial Limb company, Minneapolis, gold medal for artificial limb.

Alexander Campbell of Austin, Dodge Center Roller Mills, Frazee Roller Mills company of Pelican Rapids, and Tleson Milling company, St. Cloud, each get a bronze medal for their part of the state flour exhibit.

The Hastings Milling company of Owatonna gets an honorable mention for its part of the flour booth, and the Pillsbury-Washburn company gets honorable mention for "Vitos."

North Dakota gets a gold medal for its agricultural exhibit and private exhibitors from that state get two silver and two bronze medals and two honorable mentions.

FURTHER ADVANCE PROBABLE

Billets Are Scarce, Notwithstanding the Enormous Output of Steel.

Cleveland, Ohio, Oct. 10.—Concerning market conditions the Iron Trade Review this week will say:

Heavy buying of pig iron continues and the strength shown for some weeks in steel-rolling furnaces have not yet encountered such a buying movement as that of November, 1900, or of March, 1901, and there is free contracting for 1902, and the recent advance in prices is generally sustained.

The business of the week has been well scattered. In the Chicago district implement makers have been in the market for large amounts which come on the heels of liberal buying by malleable interests.

For the second time within the last few months President Castro of Venezuela has given offense because one of his subjects interfered with the sale of British subjects in British territory.

On the morning of Aug. 23 the Venezuelan gunboat Fotumo arrived at Patos and seized the schooner Bastora and several small boats, together with all the goods that were on shore.
