BIG MOVEMENT TO THE INTERIOR

Duluth and Superior Companies Are Receiving Liberally—Rates Are Unchanged.

Special to The Journal. Duluth, Minn., Nov. 15.—There have been received into Lake Superior this year so far 700,000 tons of hard coal, and the movement is still brisk.

As to bituminous coal the receipts for the year to this date into eleven Lake Superior ports have been 3,800,000 tons in round figures, with a week or two in which receipts will be strong.
