We have no ordinance in Minneapolis prohibiting spitting on the sidewalks, and I do not believe it would be advisable to have one. In my opinion such an ordinance could not be enforced successfully. St. Paul has an ordinance of this sort, but I defy any one to show me wherein the conditions there are any better than they are in Minneapolis.
