Berlin, Jan. 17.—The secretary of the imperial admiralty, Admiral von Tirpitz, and the chief of Emperor William's personal military staff, General von Plessen, are to accompany Prince Henry on the latter's visit to the United States.

The emperor personally is making all the arrangements that can be made on this side. The details as to how Prince Henry shall spend his time in the United States are left to Secretary Hay and Dr. von Holleben, but their general idea of the dates is this: We arrive on the Kron Prinz Wilhelm, Feb. 22, at New York.
