BAD AT BARCELONA

But the Story of a Great Battle Was Exaggerated.

RIOTS EXTENDING CONSTANTLY

Anarchists and Carlists Making the Worst Possible of the Labor Uproar.

London, Feb. 21.—Dispatches received here from Madrid and Barcelona and from various frontier towns in close touch with the scenes of the disturbances in Spain, quite discredit the sensational dispatch saying that a fierce battle had been fought between troops and rioters in the suburbs of Barcelona and that the military raked street after street, and that 600 persons were killed or wounded. Up to last evening the number of killed was but 10.

Advices received here direct from Bilbao, Valladolid, Coruna, Jigon and other industrial centers of Spain show that the attitude of regular troops and the workers is distinctly threatening. The greatest excitement prevails everywhere, but the general situation is extremely grave. It is announced in a dispatch from Madrid that General Weyler, the war minister, is urging the queen regent to give him a free hand against the "rebels in Catalonia," and that Premier Sagasta threatens to resign if General Weyler's request is granted. The queen regent is said to favor General Weyler's plan.

IN BARCELONA

Strikers Aided by London Money and by Carlists.

Barcelona, Feb. 21.—The strikers yesterday attacked the jail in an attempt to rescue their imprisoned comrades, but they were repulsed by a troop of rioters. A number of rioters had been killed or wounded. The strikers are said to be receiving large sums of money from London. Carlists are taking a hand in the disturbances.

The predominance of bayonets here has had due effect and the most turbulent spirit has been beaten out of the strikers. Outwardly the city is resuming an aspect of comparative quiet. The leading citizens are joining the military and civil authorities in their efforts to bring the town general has ordered the newspapers to resume publication and has instructed the owners of public vehicles to again enter into their regular work. The strikers refuse to work their names and residences are to be handed to the captain general, who will deal with them. All drivers declining to take out vehicles will be deprived of their licenses.

CALL IT 'IMPROVING'

Large Numbers of Anarchists and Revolutionists Arrested.

Madrid, Feb. 21.—According to this morning's advices from Barcelona the situation there has been improved. The strikers have fewer rifles, but are well supplied with revolvers and daggers. The most stringent measures have been prepared to protect regular work. The strikers have few rifles, but are well supplied with revolvers and daggers. The search of suspected houses continues; resulting in the capture of large numbers of anarchists and revolutionists of all kinds who are considered to be the prime movers in the troubles. The cosmopolitan character of Barcelona is being made use of by representatives of all the revolutionary elements in Europe, and the ranks of the malcontent workmen have been swelled by French and Italian political agitators. The republicans are busy among the troops, urging them not to use their arms against their own class in defense of the government.

THE ORIGINAL SCARE

Sanguinary Story Not Borne Out by the Facts.

Barcelona, Feb. 21.—A fierce battle has been fought between the troops and the rioters in the suburb of Barcelona known as Sano. Before the engagement cavalry and infantry had been posted in the valleys. There is a general cessation of work at Castellon de la Plana and Garve, and much excitement prevails at Batea. The general strike has been declared in those points. Delegates from the labor societies of Saragossa have visited the governor and declared themselves opposed to the strike.

HOME RULE
