THE WEATHER

The Predictions.

Minnesota—Unsettled to-night and Thursday with rain or snow in north portion; warmer in southern portion to-night; colder in north portion Thursday; increasing easterly winds. Upper Michigan—Partly cloudy to-night and Thursday; rising temperature; brisk southerly wind. Wisconsin—Fair to-night and probably Thursday; rising temperature and increasing southerly winds. Illinois—Partly cloudy to-night; Thursday unsettled with probably rain in west portion and warmer in eastern portion; southerly winds. North Dakota—Rain to-night and Thursday; southerly winds. South Dakota—Rain or snow to-night and Thursday; southerly winds. Montana—Threatening with probably snow to-night and in south portion Thursday; colder in east and south portions, northerly winds.

For Minneapolis and vicinity—Fair to-night and Thursday; warmer to-night.

Weather Conditions.

The area of warm weather now covers all the country except along the Atlantic coast, where it is slightly cooler than yesterday morning and the Pacific coast, where lower temperatures are coming on. This morning's temperatures are above the freezing point west of the Mississippi as far north as the central portions of North Dakota and Montana. Snow was falling this morning at Boston, Buffalo and Pittsburgh, but elsewhere there has been very little precipitation in the past twenty-four hours. The pressure is decidedly low in Utah, and there is a severe cold front over the New England coast. The minimum temperatures reported for the past twenty-four hours at many stations in the central part of the country are temperatures less than the observations of yesterday morning.
