SIBLEY AMENDMENT IS ADOPTED

Reduction of 20 Per Cent, to Continue Only Until the First of December, 1903.

Washington, March 19.—The advocates of Cuban reciprocity scored a victory last night at the conference of republican members of the Sibley amendment, limiting the duration of the reduced rates to Dec. 1, 1903, being adopted by a vote of 85 yeas to 81 nays.
