The Standard oil company is said to be supplying fuel oil to over 250 regular consumers in San Francisco, who have found oil as a fuel preferable to coal.

The Standard probably supplies the bulk of the trade, but in addition to the Standard, should be reckoned the Associated Oil company, the Peeries, the Thirty-three, Imperial, Monte Cristo, and other companies who, together, supply as much fuel oil as the Standard.

Of the increase in the consumption of this fuel, Mr. J. W. Harrison, the coal broker, says that three-fourths of all the factories in the city and around the bay are using oil for fuel, and that the gas companies are dropping out bituminous coals in their methods of producing light, and are using anthracite coal only with oil as an adjunct.

"I know positively," said this gentleman no longer ago than yesterday, "that many of the smaller companies of the field have completely tied themselves up for a year, and even longer with contracts to furnish oil at 3 cents a barrel. I know that they have not only agreed to sell so many barrels a month, but they have agreed to sell their entire yield, and to dump it to the cars."

"I don't believe that they can deliver the goods. I don't believe that they can even make the expense of pumping the oil to say nothing of making a profit for their stockholders, and when the show-down comes their wells will be dry, and they will have no way of doing a profitable business. It is obvious, therefore, that they will be out of business and stronger and more carefully managed companies will be selling oil at 50 cents, and perhaps more, and the Standard will be left with a loss, and finally to wind itself up. He believes that the Standard is making the move for the plain purpose of forcing the smaller companies out of the field, and to bring their wells under Standard control."
