AN ARBOR DAY TIP

Some Expert Advice on Caring for the Trees.

KEEP THE EARTH STIRRED UP

Also, Water Should Be Applied Intelligently and Pruning Done With Care.

The first Arbor Day was celebrated in Nebraska, April 10, 1872, and it has been since that time that the planting of trees on that day, mostly by school children, has also been stated, and on just as good authority, that probably less than one-half of those trees never lived beyond the first few weeks after planting.

Undoubtedly the experience of Minnesota in this regard has not been widely different from that of Nebraska, although the reasons for the great loss of trees are in the main more favorable here.

With Arbor Day but two days distant, it is worth while, perhaps, to draw passing attention to the above facts and call attention anew to the importance of proper methods of planting and the necessity of skillful care of the growing tree thereafter.

Some Expert Advice.

The trees that will be planted in Minneapolis on Friday will presumably be furnished by the city board, and this fact assures that they will arrive on the scene properly pruned and in every way in the condition for planting.

Holes are best made before the trees are brought to the ground. They should be a trifle deeper than the depth of the root system and twice as large as seems necessary.

Facilitate penetration of rains and development of roots through the loosened soil. If the soil is not of the best quality, it is well to fill the space about the tree. Do not expose the roots of the tree to the air for a single minute.

Spread the roots out naturally at the bottom of the hole and place the root down from one to three inches deeper than it grew before. Work fine dirt closely around the roots with the hand, and when they are covered, press the dirt down firmly.

ONE MORE COMET

Geneva, N. Y., April 16.—Dr. William R. Brooks, director of Smith observatory and professor of astronomy at Hobart college, announces the discovery of a new comet. It is in constellation Pegasus and an observation secured to-day makes its position right ascension 23 hours 8 minutes 10 seconds, declination north 27 degrees 25 minutes. The comet has a daily motion of about three degrees easterly and toward the sun. This is the twenty-third comet discovered by Dr. Brooks.
