High School Girls Not Over Affectionate in Schools.

**NOT LIKE THE CHICAGO GIRLS**

Comments of Local High School Principals on Recent Order of Chicago Principal.

Minneapolis teachers and scholars have been much amused by the report from Chicago that the Lake View high school girls have been forbidden by their principal to go about the halls with their arms linked together or to kiss each other in the building. The pupils were assembled in the different classrooms and the edict issued. "Affection is a good thing in its place," said the professor, "but its place is not in public. Public displays must stop. It is a bad practice," explained one of the men teachers, "and is continued for one of two reasons. Either it is done to tantalize the boys, in which case it must stop, or it is done to show affection for each other, and that I doubt."

The new rule was received with open rebellion and girls who had never thought of slipping their arms around each other did so before the principal, who stood agast at their defiance.

**Minneapolis Girls Different.**

Minneapolis high school girls are not like those in Chicago, and Professors Greer, Hobbs, Ozias and Webster state that they have never had occasion to reprimand them for an undignified public display of their affections. "The girls of Minneapolis must be of a different type from those in Chicago," said Professor Hobbs. "It is seldom that those of the North high school are seen walking with their arms intertwined. I have never seen a girl stop to kiss another in the hall and from an experience of several years I can truthfully say that the girls carry themselves in a dignified manner."

**Position Demonstrated.**

Professor Greer of the Central high school agreed with Professor Hobbs. He said that the teachers of the school endeavored to create a home atmosphere in the building and that girls were not in the habit of walking round their home with their arms about each other, and consequently they did not do it in the school building. He gave a practical illustration of his statement by taking the reporter into the hall where the pupils were passing to and from their classrooms and in the dozens and dozens of girls who passed in couples and in groups not one had her arm about another. "Strangers have always commented on the ladylike manner of the girls," remarked Professor Greer as he watched them.

Professor Ozias admitted that occasionally two girls might be seen in the South high school, arm on arm, but as they were usually sisters and their affection not to be doubted, they had never been corrected. "It is but the expression of an honest affection," he explained, "and has never been offensive in any manner."

When Professor Webster of the East high school was asked for his opinion, he gave it frankly. "I don't see why they shouldn't walk with their arms around each other if they want to. It is a custom of girls and the matter has never been questioned before. In my opinion it is ridiculous to discuss it."
