TO STUDY THE BIBLE

A Bible and Missionary Training School Under Consideration.

FIRST BAPTISTS MAY START IT

The matter to be presented at the quarterly meeting of the First Baptist church this evening, July 8, is the establishment of a Bible and Missionary Training School. The report was made by the committee on the subject, which was headed by Rev. W. B. Riley. The report was adopted by the church and the matter will be taken up at the next meeting of the church.

The report will show that the time seems ripe for such an institution on the religious field, an institution on the line of the Gordon Training school, the Baptist Training School for Women or the Moody Institute for the study of the Bible and the work of the church.

To meet partially the need of such work here Rev. W. B. Riley has conducted a comprehensive study in the Pentateuch, another in the greater doctrines of the Word and one in personal work. Assistant Pastor William Francis has for a year or more met a class of thirty weekly in a study of the Bible and Mr. Burdette and Dr. White have led in the study of missions.

The northwestern field is unoccupied. The appointments of the First church building are perfectly adapted, the officials are in perfect sympathy with the movement and the possibility of securing the necessary funds is the first order of excellence and the ardor for the undertaking is great.

The committee, F. E. Tallant, J. C. Hobbs, C. J. Rockwood, W. L. McCune and A. W. Howard, made recommendations to the officers which will be incorporated in their report to the church this evening.

That the church undertake such a school, and that the chief object of this school shall be through study of the Bible, wide acquaintance with missions, instruction in practical Christianity, and sacred music, together with some attention to medicine, English, French and Spanish.
