In North Dakota There Are 15,071,477 Acres and 11,383,413 in South Dakota.

Washington, Nov. 3.—There are 3,553,143 acres of unappropriated and unreserved lands in Minnesota...

The report says that the survey work authorized in Minnesota during the year included three contracts...
