

STURBORNNESS AND RESILIENCY IN WHEAT

Blocks of 1,000 to 10,000 Shares Are Thrown on the Market at the Opening.

Heavy Buying Orders Hold the Market Temporarily Followed by Spasms of Liquidation.

New York, Nov. 10.—The weakness of Saturday's stock market attracted heavy selling orders of 1,000 to 10,000 shares of leading stocks were thrown upon the market, causing a sharp break in the price of the general market. The opening was heavy buying orders held the market temporarily followed by spasms of liquidation.

HEAVY BUYING ORDERS STOP A PANIC.

The accumulation of selling orders over Sunday as a result of the generally discouraged tone of Saturday's market resulted in heavy pressure on the market. The first efforts at support were ineffective and prices fell lower than the opening, but it soon became apparent that there were heavy buying orders and that the bears were taking advantage of the weakness to cover large short accounts.

SPASMS OF LIQUIDATION.

The market became less active, but there were some new points of weakness before the end of the day. The second hour of trading including the Pacific, St. Paul, Reading and New York Central was at the lowest, carrying the whole market down.
