ADVANCE IS ORDERED Meeting of Traffic Officials in Chicago Yesterday.

Western traffic officials met in Chicago yesterday and ordered an advance in rates which will take effect Dec. 8 on the trunk and central lines. The advance in grain and flour rates will be 2 1/2 cents a hundred pounds and 5 cents on provisions. Rates on coal, iron, cement and other special commodities will go up from 10 to 35 per cent. No changes have been made in class rates, but the classification has been made so as to make the class rates on many articles considerably higher.

Milwaukee's Cut-Off. It is expected that by spring the Milwaukee will have completed the cut-off shortening the distance between Davenport and Ottumwa eighty miles, also that between Ashland and Thompson, Ill., sixty miles. Thus the Chicago-Kansas line will be shortened 140 miles.

Dented at Gates' Office. Chicago, Nov. 26.—The report from Milwaukee that John W. Gates had obtained control of the Wisconsin Central railroad and had reached an understanding with Mr. Rockefeller, who has a large interest in the road, that no more of the stock should be sold and that the agreement having been broken, Mr. Gates bought up the stock as it came on the market, is denied flatly at the Chicago-Kansas line. It was said there the report is wholly without foundation and Mr. Gates has no interest whatever in the Wisconsin Central.

RAILROAD NOTES. J. W. Lawhead has been made freight agent of the Rock Island at St. Paul. He has been passenger agent of the road at Des Moines, Iowa. Its thirteenth annual report just issued shows total receipts of \$2,548,250, an increase of 11.23 per cent. Net earnings were \$588,000, an increase of \$2,540. The surplus for the year shows an increase of \$104,081, making the total surplus \$396,433. Indiana school funds will receive \$685,424.75 as result of a decision in the state supreme court against the Vandalia road. The suit was for money said to be due the school, and under the charter granted in 1847, by which the road was to pay to the school fund profits in excess of specified sums.

Officials of the Santa Fe Railroad company are said to have closed a contract with French mills for 12,000 tons of steel rails of fifty pounds weight. The first lot is valued at \$22 a ton and the date of delivery is fixed for next year. Comment has been caused by this big order because the French mills are believed to be the beginning of a fight by the railroads against the steel trust. But the officials say they gave the order abroad to get it filled promptly.
