Scores Clamor for Their Dole of Coal

THE DISTRIBUTION OF ANTHRACITE IN 100-LB. LOTS ATTRACTS AN INSISTENT CROWD WHICH RECEIVES SMALL FAVORS WITH GRATITUDE.



COAL IN 100-POUND DRIBBLETS—Rush of Fuel Buyers to a Coal Car at Cedar Avenue and Lake Street Yesterday—Northwestern Fuel Company Deals Out Precious Anthracite From the Car Door.

Yesterday noon it became known that a car load of hard coal had just been switched into the yards of the Northwestern Fuel company at Cedar avenue and Lake street and would be sold in the afternoon, in hundred-pound lots, to the first comers. The time set by the company was 2 o'clock and long before that hour the office was filled with people all clamoring for tickets that were to be exchanged at the car by their fortunate possessors for the precious anthracite. Within the car, ankle deep in the coal when the sale began, and was augmented later by as many more, were men, women and children, most of them well dressed and all of them orderly although insistent. Some of them had come because of actual need and the majority of them could have bought and paid for a ton of the spot had it been procurable. Before they departed, all of them asked when the next car would be in and were told that it would probably arrive in two days.
