IN FAR AWAY PERU

Bishop I. W. Joyce Writes of His Trip Down West Coast of South America.

Observation as to South American Money and Prices—English Language Studied.

A letter from Bishop I. W. Joyce reports a delightful voyage down the west coast of South America and the good health of both the bishop and Mrs. Joyce.

"Our train ride across the Isthmus of Colon was delightful. We were in Panama only twenty-four hours. People of almost every nation seem to be there.

"There is great rejoicing along this entire coast over the prospect of having the United States take charge of the Panama canal extension.

"Hearing these and kindred expressions, gives an American very great pleasure, and awakens in him an added degree of gratitude and thanksgiving for the influence and character and stability of his government and the nation of which he is a citizen.

"Coming down the coast from Panama, we enter the republic of Ecuador at Guayaquil, that of Peru at Lima, and that of Chile at Arica. At each of these, the port physician comes on board the steamer to ascertain whether there be any cases of sickness, or not, and if there should be any found—even one case—no matter what the ailment—the ship would not be received at that port, nor allowed to proceed on her way, but the captain would be compelled to run up the yellow flag and the ship would be held in quarantine until such time as the port physician and other port officials would be satisfied that it would be safe to allow her to proceed on her way.

"A knowledge of the English language is much sought for by the young people of these various republics. Hence schools are springing up in almost every town for the purpose of teaching the same.

"The Methodist Episcopal church has several schools at strategic points on the west coast, with courses of study covering periods of three to five years, and the work of the entire course is in the English language, and the results are satisfactory in the highest degree.

"Our ship reached Callao Jan. 23, and remained in port six days. This gave me an opportunity to look about the place and also the city of Lima. Callao is the port and Lima, eight miles away, is the capital city of the Republic of Peru.

"It is summer time now in this part of the world and the climate is very much. With the exception of the heat, which was somewhat oppressive in Panama, we have not suffered the least inconvenience. Most of the time the weather has been about as we have in Minnesota.
