

TREATY VOTE 73 TO 5 EVIDENCE IS ALL IN OLSON READY TO DIE

The Senate Is Almost Unanimous in Passing the Canal Measure.

Have the Experts for the Defense Saved Hamlet, on Trial at Iowa City?

Aitkin's Condemned Murderer Concedes He Has Forfeited the Right to Live.

The Negative Votes Cast by the Virginia and Alabama Senators and Teller.

"Delusional Melancholia" Was His Trouble, They Say, and He Was Not Responsible.

Takes His Place on the Gallows Where He Will Be Executed on Friday.

Washington, March 18.—Without dotting an "i" or crossing a "t" or even without changing a single punctuation mark, the senate yesterday voted to ratify the treaty with the republic of Colombia for the construction of an isthmian canal.

Special to The Journal. Iowa City, Iowa, March 18.—"Delusional melancholia," that's what ailed Hamlet, declared the Danish prince's attorney in the trial of the junior law court of the University of Iowa to-day.

Special to The Journal. Aitkin, Minn., March 18.—The governor's order to carry out the execution of Ole Olson on Friday morning was received here yesterday afternoon.

As soon as the ratifications are exchanged \$20,000,000 will be paid to the government of Colombia for the concessions granted by the treaty, including its stock in the Panama railroad and annual payments of \$250,000 from the railroad concession.

They swore it was their best judgment that Hamlet suffered from delusional melancholia, superinduced by brooding over his father's death.

Olson eats and sleeps well and appears indifferent regarding his fate. He, however, asks that he be kept in the hospital until he is able to read the papers.
