Geographical Society of England \$500. Captain Amundsen is only 30 years old and has made one successful expedition in the Antarctic regions. His second in command will be Lieutenant Godfred Hansen. 27 years of age. The other mem-bers will be Anton Lund and Helmer Hansen, skilled harpoonists, Sergeant Peter Ristveldt, machinist; Gustav J. Wilk, asstant: and Andrew Pedersen, steward. The eighth member will be a physician of scientific bent.
