To-day's Shipments More Than Double Those of Any Monday for a Month. New rates on flour, the result of the recent conference of eastern and western trunk line men in Chicago, became effective to-day.

Increasing the Output. The outlook is for the resumption of grinding by the mills, yet there may not be any more mills started just at present.

Flour rates east of Chicago are now 18c domestic and 15c export. With the proportionate share of the Minneapolis local rate, the present flour rate on four from Minneapolis to New York is 25c.
