LETTER CARRIERS ORGANIZE Meet in Chicago to Form a National Association. Chicago, Sept. 11.—Rural letter carriers of the United States will meet in Chicago to-day and to-morrow to form a national association. There will be in attendance delegates representing 17,000 rural letter carriers, who daily supply 12,000,000 country residents with mail. They travel 500,000 miles every day, their routes covering two-thirds of the best farming districts of America. Better roads, more salary, fewer privations, holidays, and numerous other improvements in their conditions are the hopes of the rural carriers, who declare they travel over the worst roads in the world. Heretofore the rural carriers have had many organizations. Now it is the intention to have all the state organizations subsidiary to the national body. The organization will be known as the National Rural Free Delivery Letter Carriers' association.
