

### CUBAN BILL IS CONSIDERED

It Is Reported In From Ways and Means Committee—Vote to Come Thursday.

Democrats Object to Rule Providing for Such Vote, but in Vain.

Washington, Nov. 16.—The house began the consideration of the Cuban reciprocity bill today. Mr. Dalzell (Rep., Pa.) reported a rule providing that the bill should be considered on the exclusion of all other business until 4 p. m. Thursday, when a vote should be taken, without intervening business.

Mr. Williams (Dem. Miss.) speaking for the minority, declared the proposed rule was about the most drastic ever introduced in the house, saying it shut off all right to perfect the bill. He said that the minority desired to offer an amendment which proposed to strike out the "double-barreled pledge" contained in the bill.

Mr. Dalzell, replying to the charge that the rule was a most drastic measure, reverted to the time when the Wilson bill was pending.

Mr. Grosvenor (Ohio) said: "The minority wants to mutilate the bill and says: 'It is a child of theirs, but...'"

New York, Nov. 16.—Rev. Joseph Cirrione, rector of the Italian Church of the Immaculate Conception in Williamsbridge, a suburb of this city, who disappeared under mysterious circumstances last Friday night, was found early today by a policeman in East Fifty-first street, having hid in an Italian, and is now in a hospital.

Father Cirrione has incurred the enmity of Italians by a crusade against vice. He received several threatening letters and had reported to the police, who were endeavoring to locate the writers.

A physician found on his wrist two red marks such as would have been made by a rope. Under the influence of sedatives he became calmer and was able to tell something of his story.

New York, Nov. 16.—The agents here of the Clyde line steamer Cherokee, which had trouble with the Dominican government authorities on her last trip to that island, declared today that she will not sail next Wednesday on her regular schedule and will pursue her regular itinerary, stopping at Samana bay, Monte Cristi, Sanchez, Puerto Plata and Macoris.

Consul Gavan said: "Acting on orders from my government, I have notified Collector Stranahan that the ports of Samana bay, Sanchez, Puerto Plata, Monte Cristi and Macoris are closed and that the Clyde steamers cannot be cleared or them."
