LAND LAWS ARE NOT ADEQUATE

SECRETARY HITCHCOCK ON INTERIOR AFFAIRS.

Annual Report of the Department Covers Entries and Sales of Land—Frauds Have Not Been Numerous—Addition to Forest Reserves—Indian Lands and Timber in Minnesota—Irrigation, Pensions, Etc.

Washington, Dec. 15.—Existing laws relating to the public lands says Secretary Hitchcock in his report of the interior department, "in many instances do not provide adequate protection for the interests of the government, and remedial legislation should be enacted by congress at the earliest practicable date."

There were disposed of during the fiscal year ended June 30, 1903, public lands aggregating 22,824,293.45 acres, classified as follows: Cash sales, 2,073,896.99 acres; miscellaneous entries, embracing homesteads, land warrants, scrip locations, state selections, swamp lands, railroad and wagonroad selections, Indian allotments, etc., 19,577,031.10 acres; and Indian lands, 1,277,365.36 acres, showing an increase of 3,335,764.35 acres as compared with the aggregate disposals for the preceding fiscal year.

The total cash receipts during the fiscal year from various sources, including disposal of public land, \$10,557,618.66, and Indian land, \$308,938.14; from depositions on public lands, \$95,251.31; from sales of timber on forest reserves, \$31,966.24; from sales of government property, \$849.82; and for furnishing copies of reports and plans, \$30,118.48; aggregate, \$11,024,743.65, an increase of \$4,762,816.47 over the preceding fiscal year.

The total expenses of district land offices for salaries and commissions of registers and receivers, incidental expenses and expenses of depositing public moneys during the fiscal year ended June 30, 1903, were \$828,862.82, an increase, as compared with the fiscal year ended June 30, 1902, of \$10,364.02.

There were 312 cases of depositions upon public timbered lands reported during the year, involving timber to the value of \$622,099.11, a decrease of \$770,907.73 from last year. In ninety-six cases, the recommendation was made for the recovery of a certain amount of \$2,976,238.66, the value of timber alleged to have been taken unlawfully from public lands, and 310

Indian Reservations, including 159,313.18 acres, of which 96,196.44 acres were classified as "pine" lands, on which there were estimated to be 27,512,000 feet of pine timber.

The examiners then moved to the Red Lake reservation, where they examined to Sept. 21, 1903, an area of 775,135.90 acres, of which 24,245.34 acres are reported as "pine" lands, estimated to contain 26,378 feet of timber.

On March 2, 1903, the first sale of pine timber under the acts cited was held at the district land office at Crookston, Minn., there being offered 20,678,000 feet of pine, described as being on 12,210.77 acres in sections 16 and 36 on the Red Lake and four ceded townships on the White Earth Indian reservations. Sealed bids were received for 14,771,000 feet of timber, estimated to be on 7,737.19 acres, the bids ranging from \$5 to \$6.05 for white pine and \$4 to \$4.75 for Norway, and aggregating \$58,674.70. There were no bids received on Dec. 28, 1902, of timber, described as being on 4,474.69 acres, doubtless due to the fact that more than the amount of timber mentioned had been removed by authorities of the state and settlement made therefor.
